**Pentecost Offering:** This morning, we will receive the Pentecost Offering. The Pentecost Offering is about uniting young people in Christ. 60% of the offering supports the Presbyterian Mission Agency to support: 1) the Young Adult Volunteers program, 2) Ministries with Youth program, and 3) advocacy for children at risk. The remaining 40% of the offering goes to support local youth programs. Each year on Pentecost we celebrate the arrival of the Holy Spirit who brings new life and the Pentecost Offering helps young people in Christ gain a strong start in their developing faith.

**Bicycling Outing:** Our next Bicycling Event features historic town of Occoquan.
